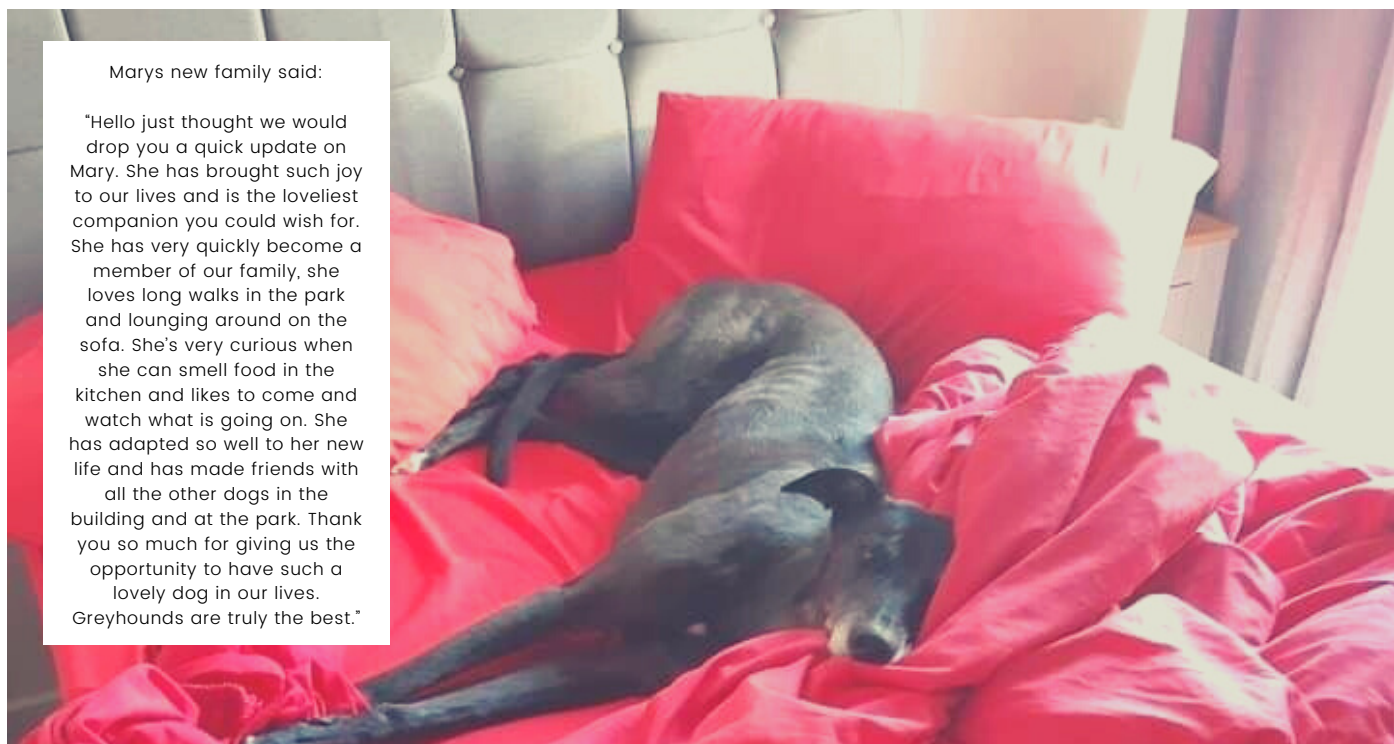


MAY NEWSLETTER
